FINAL REPORT OF THE
1997 SPRING TERM DADE COUNTY GRAND JURY

Many of us share the belief that our government's power has been perverted to procure exclusive privileges for a select few. This distrustful legacy creates in us a willingness to believe that all government is corrupt. The recent revelations that important governmental leaders had fallen prey to improper financial enticements seem only to confirm this belief. Each new incident and revelation tore at the very heart of our trust and faith in government. Unfortunately, criminal convictions can only punish discovered acts. They inadequately address the underlying suspicion that a more subtle form of corruption, relating to the favored treatment of the powerful few, still remains untouched. We think that this insidious type of corruption, while generally not criminal in nature, is as destructive to our trust in government as revelations of overt criminal bribery. No official deed is more vile nor official act more repulsive than a breach by government of the public's trust and the treatment of some citizens as "more equal" than others.

At the request of our State Attorney, Katherine Fernandez Rundle, we have spent our term examining these issues and, in particular, certain questionable actions of the Dade County Department of Planning, Development and Regulation, an agency more commonly recognized by its former name, the Department of Building and Zoning. Initially, we felt that we could successfully complete our mission and render a thoughtful and analytical report within the limited time allotted to us during our grand jury term. Unfortunately, we could never have imagined that the issues involved and the information we have uncovered would have proven to be so complex and so difficult to fully investigate. We have found what we believe to be favored treatment, improper actions and incorrect motivations. However, we also believe that what we have uncovered may only be the tip of an enormous iceberg. Our review of these disturbing issues has been our top priority. However, despite our more than six months of service, we have been forced to recognize that our inquiry has only just begun.

As individuals, we would have greatly desired the closure that the issuance of a detailed report would bring to us all. Equally desirable would be the opportunity for us to make broad recommendations for changes within this Dade County agency. However, as grand jurors, we think that to do so now while so much of our work still remains incomplete, would be an irresponsible and selfish act. Our community deserves no less than a full and complete inquiry of this important subject. It is our opinion that the time limitations of our grand jury term should not cause or compel the examination of this topic into a conclusion that is premature.

Accordingly, we have passed the torch of our inquiry on to our successor Grand Jury. Unquestionably and unanimously, we believe this to be the correct, responsible and honest thing for us to do. This next Grand Jury has agreed with our measure of the importance of this topic. They will devote their term, their energies and their independent analysis to the continuation and conclusion of our investigation, in addition to the investigations of other governmental entities, agencies and systems they may choose to undertake. As a result, we can now conclude our grand jury service secure in the knowledge that the work we have started during our term will continue and that the interests of our community will be correctly and appropriately served.


